Facilities:	Security Cameras are being installed inside and outside of the elementary building. New doors are being installed in elementary and gym to increase security and address door defects.
Parent Partnership:	The Parent Outreach program was paused due to other priorities. We are picking things back up with a focus on how and where to reach families to deepen the connection and relationship with all stakeholders. Recent discussions have centered around the space in which we communicate with families since traditional methods seem to have had decreased outcomes. Our attention is on using the social media space that all families are engaged in to disseminate information, guidance and to create a connection outside of a traditional note home from the principal.
Technology:	All chromebooks have been delivered. Approximately450 computers arrived and everyone on our list with needs should have or be in the process of getting one.
