Make-ups and Read to Achieve are scheduled for next week.</p> <p>Despite the high number of virtual learners participation has been good. 95% of students, at this time, are scheduled to complete all of their EOG assessments.</p> <p>Preliminary results show a dip in proficiency levels which we fully anticipated.</p> <p>Reading results for grades 4-8 will not be back until the fall. <b>Covid-19 Update</b>	Students are no longer required to wear masks on the playground. Families have the choice to instruct their children to keep their masks on. Mask wearing continues in the building.
