Student academic performance growth in most grade levels in all subject areas based on Iready. Uncertainty if Case 21 is going to be aligned with EOG outcomes

Enrollment: Enrollment at both schools has seen attrition through the year mostly due to relocations and homeschool and other events. A complete accounting of attrition and reasons will be shared in May in the end of year board reports.

Enrollment for next year is looking very promising. Both schools have hundreds of applications and continue to receive new applications post lottery every week. Both schools will accept between 12-18% over enrollment depending on the grade level to ensure the school hits its enrollment target and overcompensates for summer withdraws and moves and kids eho do not show up immediately as in the past.

## Financials

All financials are moving in the right direction. Both schools will continue to maximize grant funds for support roles, supplemental materials and contracted services which will leave both schools with a positive gain in fund balance. Expenses to schools is in kitchen upgrades that are largely complete. MCSA food service is growing daily and we expect to see the same when SCA is in full swing.

MCSA introduced 2 teachers of the year and shared their instructional achievements and contributions to the programs overall. One teacher is a new teacher (a) SCSA introduced one teacher of the year who has been with SCSA for second year and brings a lot of experience.
