Academics	<p><b>MOY Benchmark</b> assessment data:</p> <p>Both <a href="#">Case21</a> and <a href="#">iReady</a> data show growth overall. In the few areas with weaker growth we have employed additional assistance to the teachers and students. It's important to note that historically, in some grades we see a dip in the MOY assessment data due to timing related to pacing.</p> <p>Big note is iReady increases which show that students are closing gaps in learning foundational skills.</p> <p>Action Plan:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continue Tier 2 and 3 intervention for students not showing growth.</li><li>• After school tutoring is offered to high needs students including EC students.</li><li>• EOG prep will roll out in March.
